- Ps 111:2 MSG-- God's works are so great, worth a lifetime of study endless enjoyment!
- Ps 103:2 NLT-- Praise the LORD, I tell myself, and never forget the good things he does for me.
- Ps 143:5 NLT-- I remember the days of old. I ponder all your great works. I think about what you have done
- <u>Deut 4:9 MSG</u>-- Don't forget anything of what you've seen. Don't let your heart wander off. Stay vigilant as long as you live.
- <u>Josh 23:14 NLT</u>-- Every promise of the LORD your God has come true. Not a single one has failed!
- Neh 4:14 AMP-- Do not be afraid of the enemy; [earnestly] remember the Lord and imprint Him [on your minds], great and terrible, and [take from Him courage to] fight
- Rev 3:3 AMP-- Call to mind the lessons you received and heard; continually lay them to heart and obey them
- Ps 111:4 MSG-- His miracles are his memorial This God of Grace, this God of Love.
- Ps 63:5-6 AMP-- My whole being shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness; and my mouth shall
 praise You with joyful lips when I remember You upon my bed and meditate on You in the night

- Ps 77:14 NLT-- You are the God of miracles and wonders!
- Ps 106:7 AMP-- Our fathers in Egypt understood not nor appreciated Your miracles; they did not [earnestly] remember the multitude of Your mercies nor imprint Your loving-kindness [on their hearts], but they were rebellious and provoked the Lord
- <u>Ps 111:4 AMP</u>-- He has made His wonderful works to be remembered; the Lord is gracious, merciful, and full of loving compassion.
- <u>Is 12:4 NAS</u>-- Give thanks to the LORD, call on His name. Make known His deeds among the peoples
- <u>Is 46:9 AMP</u>—[Earnestly] remember the former things, [which I did] of old; for I am God, and there is no one else; I am God, and there is none like Me,
- Ps 77:11 AMP-- I will [earnestly] recall the deeds of the Lord; yes, I will [earnestly] remember the wonders [You performed for our fathers] of old.
- <u>Ps 105:5 AMP</u>-- Earnestly remember the marvelous deeds that He has done, His miracles and wonders, the judgments and sentences which He pronounced upon His enemies
- <u>Deut 4:9 NLT</u>-- But watch out! Be very careful never to forget what you have seen the LORD do for you. Do not let these things escape from your mind as long as you live! And be sure to pass them on to your children and grandchildren.
- <u>Is 46:9 NLT</u>-- Do not forget the things I have done throughout history. For I am God I alone! I am God, and there is no one else like me
- 1 Cor 10:1 NLT-- I don't want you to forget, dear brothers and sisters, what happened to our ancestors in the wilderness long ago. God guided all of them by sending a cloud that moved along ahead of them, and he brought them all safely through the waters of the sea on dry ground.
- Heb 13:8 NLT-- Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.
- Ps 103:2 MSG-- O my soul, bless God, don't forget a single blessing!
- Ps 63:2 NIV-- I have seen you in the sanctuary and beheld your power and your glory
- Ps 77:11 MSG-- Once again I'll go over what God has done, lay out on the table the ancient wonders
- Ps 103:2 KJV-- Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits
- <u>Ps 78:2-4 MSG</u>-- I'm chewing on the morsel of a proverb; I'll let you in on the sweet old truths, stories we heard from our fathers, counsel we learned at our mother's knee. We're not keeping this to ourselves, we're passing it along to the next generation God's fame and fortune, the marvelous things he has done.

- Phil 4:19 NLT-- And this same God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from his glorious riches, which have been given to us in Christ Jesus.
