- Ps 56:3-4, 8, 9b, 10 NAS -- When I am afraid, I will put my trust in You. ⁴ In God, whose word I praise, in God I have put my trust; I shall not be afraid. What can *mere* man do to me?... ⁸ You have taken account of my wanderings; put my tears in Your bottle. Are *they* not in Your book?... ^{9b} This I know, that God is for me. ¹⁰ In God, whose word I praise, in the LORD, whose word I praise,
- Heb 9:28 NIV -- So Christ was sacrificed once to take away the sins of many; and he will appear a second time, not to bear sin, but to bring salvation to those who are waiting for him.
- Ps 143:8 NAS -- Let me hear Your lovingkindness in the morning; for I trust in You; Teach me the way in which I should walk; for to You I lift up my soul.
- 2 Cor 4:18 NIV -- So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.
- Jm 1:2-3 ESV -- Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness.
- Ex 14:14 ESV -- The LORD will fight for you, and you have only to be silent.

- Ps 40:1-3 -- I waited patiently for the LORD; and He inclined to me and heard my cry. ² He also brought me up out of a horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, *and* established my steps. ³ He has put a new song in my mouth—Praise to our God; many will see *it* and fear and will trust in the LORD.
